Section VI            Male or Female – 18 years + - Adult  
Male or Female under 18 years – Junior  
Family – 2 Adults member and spouse/significant other living in the same household & Kids Children/grandchildren under 18

Section VIII            Shooting Fees

- A.    Stockholders pay posted Stockholder shooting fees.
- B.    Family members of Stockholders who maintain Stockholder-Family memberships pay posted Stockholder shooting fees.
- C.    Family members of Stockholders who DO NOT maintain Stockholder-Family memberships pay posted Non-Member shooting fees.
- D.    Social members pay posted Social Member shooting fees.
- E.    Family members of Social Members who maintain Social-Family memberships pay posted Social Member shooting fees.
- F.    Family members of Social Members who DO NOT maintain Social-Family memberships pay posted Non-Member shooting fees.
